OUR VOICE ON THE WAY TO BELÉM



The Amazonian Indigenous Pre-COP is a political and technical meeting of the peoples of the basin, convened by COICA, to define and validate the Amazonian Indigenous Positioning ahead of COP30.

The Pre-COP is being held in compliance with the **unanimous decision of the COICA Coordination Council (CCC)**, adopted in Brasilia on 1 June 2025, with the participation of the presidents of the nine grassroots organisations, the Board of Directors and former General Coordinators.



A moment that will go down in history

- Because the indigenous peoples of the nine Amazonian countries speak with one voice.
- Because concrete solutions are developed from the territories.
- Because leaders, elders, women, young people and communities participate directly through online consultations.
- Because it will promote the Document of Proposals for Amazonian Territorial Solutions as a tool for international advocacy.



How we will work: from words to proposal

- Construction that integrates the work carried out by territorial bases, Pre-COP COIAB, ORPIA, strategies and proposals from OPIAC, AIDSESP, CIDOB, APA, OIS, and collective online consultations.
- Thematic co-creation tables with leaders, elders, women, and youth.
- Culturally relevant methodologies, with respectful dialogue between knowledge systems.
- Practical and applicable results, ready to guide advocacy at COP30.

The 7 Routes of Amazonian Solutions

- Direct financing without debt.
- Adaptation and resilience with an Indigenous face.
- Standing forests and protected territories.
- Carbon markets with safeguards.
- Just transition without green extractivism.
- Loss, damage, and climate reparation.
- Full participation in climate governance.



Youth raising their voices

- Direct participation in the Pre-COP: delegations of indigenous youth integrated into thematic roundtables and spokesperson spaces.
- Preparatory Virtual Course: to strengthen advocacy, negotiation, and leadership skills.
- Online consultation: open to indigenous youth and leaders who wish to contribute their ideas, which will be recognised in the systematisation and digital mural of the Pre-COP.



Stages of preparation and projection - Road to COP30

National Pre-COPs

01

The grassroots organizations (ORPIA, AIDSEP, COIAB, OPIAC, CIDOB) held prior meetings to collectively analyze the context and develop territorial proposals.

02

Collective strategies and documents

Based on the national inputs, political documents and strategies for Amazonian Indigenous advocacy were developed.

Regional participation of COICA

03

The peoples, through COICA, participated in regional and global spaces of analysis, building proposals and positioning territorial governance as a climate key.

04

Preparatory Virtual Course

A training space aimed at Indigenous youth and leaders to strengthen leadership, spokespersonship, and negotiation tools.

Online Consultation

05

An open process for Indigenous youth, women leaders, and leaders to directly contribute to the Amazonian Positioning.

06

Amazonian Indigenous Pre-COP

A high-level political meeting where the Amazonian Positioning Document will be consolidated and the Amazonian Territorial Solutions Document will be presented.

Virtual Results Course

07

Feedback to youth and leaders on the systematized proposals and the advocacy strategy defined in the Pre-COP.

08

Participation in COP30

Amazonian delegations with their own voice in negotiations, plenaries, and strategic events.

Analysis of Results

09

Political and technical evaluation of Indigenous advocacy at COP30, with feedback to the grassroots.

10

Post-COP30 Strategy

Definition of a regional roadmap to ensure continuity, monitoring of commitments, and positioning of the Amazonian agenda in global spaces.
